The following information is a quick overview of the policies of the Keystone Cemetery. These interment policies and guidelines are described in greater detail in the Keystone Cemetery By-Laws. Copies of the By-Laws are available at the cemetery office and may be reviewed upon request with the office.

INTERMENTS

A. Residents: Interments shall be limited to persons who are residents of the district, persons who are former residents, persons who pay property taxes on property within the

district, persons who formerly paid taxes within the district, eligible nonresidents of the district and persons who are family members as defined in Section 9060 of The Health & Safety Code, which consist of the following: Spouse; Child, Stepchild or Adopted Child; Parent; Brother or Sister, or any person denoted by the prefix “Grand” or “Great” in their relation to the person in question or the spouse of any of these persons.

B. Non-residents: One should review the Keystone Cemetery By-Laws for an in-depth explanation of who is an eligible non-resident.

CREMATIONS

Only cremated remains, known as cremains, are allowed in the cremation lot at the front area of the cemetery. Two burials are allowed per site. If space is available, cremains may also be placed above an occupied full-sized plot. Two cremains may be placed on top of a full-sized burial. If a full-sized plot is unoccupied, then a maximum of four cremains may be buried on a full-sized plot. Each cremains burial must be covered with enough earth so that the top of the urn or other container is at least 2 feet underground.

FORMS AND CHARGES FOR SERVICES

No interment or other services shall be rendered until a Permit of Disposition is received by the cemetery, and all charges for burial rights, services and endowment fees have been paid in full. A Receipt and Burial Rights Certificate will be issued to each buyer at the time of payment in full for all charges.

DIGGING OF BURIAL PLOT

It is not the responsibility of the Keystone Cemetery to provide excavators, lifts, or other

services for digging of a burial space or vault. Names and phone numbers of possible local contractors with the required insurance and digging equipment may be obtained from the Cemetery Manager or your Funeral Director.

PRICE LIST

Plots/Spaces: All Burials prices include the Endowment Fee, Plot Reservation Fee, and Marker Fee. A Temporary Marker is required by law for all burials unless a Permanent Marker exists or is added at the time of burial, including the name of the deceased and dates of birth and death. Endowment Fees are required by law and are used to maintain the cemetery grounds.
